Requirements:

- Students must attend bi-weekly mentoring sessions – attendance will be recorded at the beginning of each session.
 - If a lunch session is missed, your mentor should be notified immediately of the reason for it to be excused.
 - After-school sessions are encouraged to attend.
 - Virtual mentoring sessions are optional.
- **Positive Behavioral Intervention and Support (PBIS)**
 - If a student receives a behavioral plan, it must be submitted to Legacy Driven within 48-72 hours of receiving the plan.
 - We will discuss the plan with each student and possibly follow-up with the teacher.
- Homeroom teacher student reports will be submitted to Legacy Driven in the areas of: behavior/conduct, focus, dependability, emotional health, peer relationships and work ethic. **(Once per month)**

Academics:

- Progress report shall be submitted to LDF every reporting period via our website.
- Grade(s) below 70 – an explanation of what steps are being/will be taken to improve in that subject matter must be submitted to LDF via our website.
- School support is non-existent – if the school is NOT giving or has not offered additional support for the subject matter(s) where the student's grade is 70 or below, a “Letter of Support” may be requested. (Note: Facts will be gathered before a letter is written on the student’s behalf.)

Social Media - Each student is encouraged to pick out one to two days every week throughout the school year that social media is **NOT** viewed on a device! (a day = 24 hours, excludes school days off)

Note: Foundation staff reserves the right to speak to teachers, counselors and/or any other support member that is involved with the youth’s education, at any time during the school year.
